1. WELCOME



RCA Chair Cr Kevin Mack Mayor, City of Albury welcomed RCA members to the Board

Members noted the following updates for the Issues Register:



- Secretariat to meet with the Hon Alex Hawke MP Minister for Immigration, Citizenship, Migrant Services and Multicultural Affairs, to discuss regional migration policy;
- Secretariat to meet with the new Executive Director of the Regional Universities Network (RUN), Mr Alec Webb to confirm ongoing MoU and strategic partnership with RCA;
- Members are in the process of providing feedback on the National Farmers' Federation's 'regional development precincts' model; and
- RCA draft policy positions for the upcoming federal election have been sent out to Board Members for review.

Members noted the following updates in relation to the Membership Status Grid:

- RCA Chair Cr Kevin Mack Mayor, City of Albury has met with Alice Springs Town Council recently to discuss ongoing RCA Membership, and expects feedback in November 2021;
- City of Bunbury have elected a new mayor, Mayor Jaysen De San Miguel. Cr Grant Henley Mayor, City of Busselton will meet with the new mayor on 29 October 2021 to discuss RCA Membership.

Members received and noted all reports and registers. Cr Col Murray - Mayor, Tamworth

Regional Council moved to endorse the reports and registers, Cr Daniel Moloney – Mayor, City of Ballarat seconded.

5. THE HON CATHERINE KING MP

RCA Chair Cr Kevin Mack Mayor, City of Albury welcomed Hon Catherine King MP to the meeting. Cr Daniel Moloney – Mayor, City of Ballarat introduced Hon Catherine King MP as the local member for Ballarat and Shadow Minister for Infrastructure, Transport and Regional Development.

Hon Catherine King MP discussed the following issues:

- Regional growth was high on the agenda, particularly given there has been a 200% increase in net growth to regional centres and regional areas during the COVID-19 pandemic;
- Regional grant programs were an issue that was firmly in her purview, indicating that the ALP would be reviewing the equity of the current scheme; and
- She acknowledged that building resilient regions is reliant on connected, liveable and diversified local economies, with access to needs-based funding.

RCA highlighted the pressing need for underlying infrastructure investment to match the population growth.

7. GENERAL BUSINESS

Members discussed and noted/agreed to an online/virtual Delegation for November 2021. RCA Chair Cr Kevin Mack Mayor, City of Albury noted that it was Cr Col Murray's – Mayor, Tamworth Regional Council last RCA meeting, and thanked him for his service and membership with RCA since 2014. The meeting was closed at 1:05pm AEDT.
