1. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF COUNTRY, WELCOME AND INTRODUCTION

RCA Chair Cr Kylie King – Mayor, Albury City Council, opened the meeting, welcomed members to the meeting and noted apologies.

2. CONFIRMATION OF MEETING MINUTES

RCA Chair Cr Kylie King – Mayor, Albury City Council, tabled the draft minutes from the previous February 2024 meeting.

Ms Rachael Sweeney – Secretariat provided an update on the actions from the RCA February 2024 Board Meeting. Members received and noted the minutes and updates.

Mayor Peter Carter – Mayor, Town of Port Hedland moved the minutes as a true and accurate record of the meeting. Mayor Jerry Clune – Mayor, City of Greater Geraldton seconded the motion.

RCA Chair, Cr Kylie King – Mayor, Albury City Council noted consensus from members to endorse the RCA February 2024 Meeting Minutes.

3. FINANCIAL UPDATE

RCA Treasurer Mr Frank Zaknich – GM, Albury City Council tabled the February 2024 Treasurer's Report and provided an overview of the accounts to date for the information of members.

RCA Chair Cr Kylie King – Mayor, Albury City Council noted consensus to endorse the February 2024 reports from members.

5. NBN PRESENTATION

RCA Chair Cr Kylie King – Mayor, Albury City Council welcomed Mr Thomas O'Dea – Head of NBN Local NSW Regional Development and Engagement, and Mr Chris Cusack – National General Manager, NBN to the meeting and introduced all members.

Mr Thomas O'Dea – Head of NBN Local NSW Regional Development and Engagement, NBN provided an overview of NBN's activities to date, including:

- 3.5 million premises on the Fibre to the Node (FTTN) technology will be able eligible to upgrade to Fibre to the Premises (FTTP) by the end of 2025 on an eligible plan;
- 1.5 million premises on the Fibre to the Curb technology will be able to upgrade to FTTP on an eligible plan; and
- 2.5 million premises on the HFC network can access the NBN Home Ultrafast plan.

Mr Thomas O'Dea - Head of NBN Local NSW Regional Development and Engagement, NBN noted eligible upgrade areas could expect the following the support:

- End to end ownership and management complaints hotline;
- Operation council engagement and communication through delivery partners;
- Community stakeholder engagement and communication through delivery partners; and
- Regular updates are available through the NBN website.

Mr Chris Cusack – National General Manager, NBN noted upgrades would be communicated through the following platforms:

- face to face sessions;
- communications through local media, newsletters and social media;
- Geo-targeted social and media communications; and
- Regular updates through the NBN website.

Mr Chris Cusack – National General Manager, NBN noted localised briefings on BNB activities and upgrades are available for all regional areas upon request.

Members noted the presentation.
